FM110	Sustainability Management	CPE Commercial Real Estate	This comprehensive course is designed to provide the skills and tools to lead change management and sustainability initiatives that deliver triple bottomline results across the spectrum of voluntary programs and compliance mandates. Starting with building level results and energy management cost savings, this class will demonstrate how today's facility managers can identify and articulate the value proposition of sustainability efforts to advance their careers and relevance within the organization.
FM111	Sustainable Approaches to Energy Design	CPE Commercial Real Estate	This course provides an in-depth analysis of the design and performance issues, as well as costs, associated with energy-consuming building elements, including the building envelope, HVAC, service water, power, lighting, and other electrical equipment (ASHRAE 90.1 2007 Sections 5-10). Students will explore basic energy modeling tools and techniques as well as the design, construction, and operations of different systems, and are expected to have a basic understanding of basic building design, construction, and systems.
FM112	Renewable Sustainable Energy	CPE Commercial Real Estate	Students gain a basic understanding of the performance, advantages, reliability, costs, incentives, paybacks, permitting, design, construction, and operations of commercial scale renewable and alternative energy systems. Lectures include concentration on the interconnection with the utility infrastructure. Discussions will include the financial analysis of different systems including ROI, payback periods, taxes, and utility and other state or local incentives and grants.
