The Metropolitan Action Committee on Violence Against Women and Children (METRAC) is proud to have partnered with the Royal Roads Student Association on its *Engaging Young People to Prevent Violence against Women on Post-Secondary Campuses* project. With funding provided by Status of Women Canada, the Student Association has been able to contract METRAC to lead a safety audit of Royal Roads University between March and August of this year. This has included completing key informant interviews and focus groups with staff and students; surveying students both on-line and in-person; reviewing the school's safety-related policies and procedures; and training and leading staff and students in walkabouts on the University's campus.

It has been a pleasure to work alongside the dedicated executive members of the Student Association and Students Services and project staff as we carry out this campus safety audit. These persons demonstrate a considerable level of commitment to student engagement and leadership. The opportunity to learn from campus members about safety at the school has been very valuable and we look forward to tabling our report with recommendations for the Student Association and Administration to consider implementing.
