

Applied Sustainability Research at Grand Valley State University

Two methodologies were used to count the number of sustainability researchers:

- 1) The first was a review of Digital Measures. 32 faculty members checked the “sustainability” box or mentioned sustainability in their title.
- 2) The second methodology was a review of department and faculty websites.

The results from each method were then compared to eliminate duplicate entries.

The result is a total of 93 sustainability researchers at Grand Valley State University.
